SUMMARY

The BILT project is currently developing a Self-Reflection Tool intended to allow TVET providers to assess their preparedness to identify new qualifications and competencies, integrate them into curricula and implement them in adequate learning environments. For this purpose, the BILT project is selecting six UNEVOC Centres - TVET providers from Africa, Asia and Pacific as well as Europe (two from each region) to co-develop and pilot the Self-Reflection Tool, to implement a Guided Self-Reflection Workshop and to scale up the updated version of the Tool to (at least) three other UNEVOC Centres - TVET providers.
