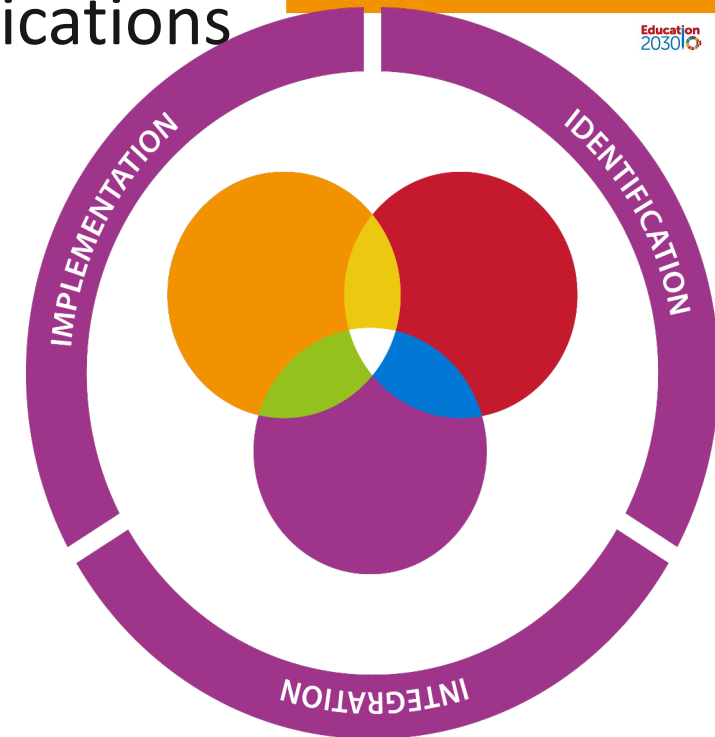
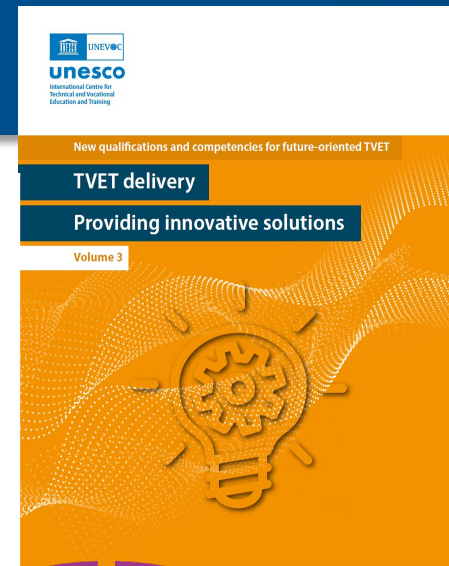
Objective: support TVET providers to prepare for identifying, integrating + implementing new skills into curricula + qualifications.

Process: with managers, teachers, learners + partners

- **Step 1:** Map current practices and priorities in new qualifications and competencies
- **Step 2:** Analyze strengths and opportunities to improve institutional performance

Result = Action Plan

- 15 quantitative indicators
- In-depth qualitative reflection
