

## **Shenzhen Polytechnic Won 2 Gold Awards in the International ‘Internet +’ Competition**

On 19<sup>th</sup> Nov. 2020, the 6<sup>th</sup> China International College Students’ ‘Internet +’ Innovation and Entrepreneurship Competition was held in Guangzhou, China. Held by 12 Ministries and the Guangdong Provincial Government, China, this competition has enjoyed great influence and reputation in China and abroad. This year it has attracted 1.47 million teams to participate, with 6.31 million students from 4,186 institutions among 117 countries and regions.

Two student teams from the UNEVOC Centre @Shenzhen Polytechnic (SZPT) has won gold awards in the TVET group in this competition.
